

## BC Ministry of Education student transcript issue

On Tuesday, July 30, 2019, the BC Ministry of Education announced that they would review every June 2019 exam result to ensure student grades were accurately reflected on their transcripts. This was a result of indications that some secondary students in BC and Yukon may have had incorrect exam results on their final transcripts due to an "anomaly" in the tabulation of Grade 12 provincial exams written in June.

On Wednesday, July 31, the BC Minister of Education, Rob Fleming, released a [statement](#) indicating that the issue had been resolved and updated grade results are accurate. In the statement, Minister Fleming indicated that the BC Ministry's investigation of the issue "discovered that human error caused the incident when data was being manually transferred between systems".

The BC Ministry of Education's [Student Transcript Service](#) site has been updated to ensure all students have their updated results. All Post-Secondary Institutions who would normally receive student transcripts electronically were notified to ensure that student acceptance to universities would not be affected by the issue. All Post-Secondary Institutions who are not set up to receive electronic transmission will receive paper transcripts through mail, as per the usual process.
