



Early Immersion Kindergarten Pre-Registration Process for 2017 – 18 school year

KEY DATES

- **Monday, February 13, 9:00 a.m.**
 - Online Kindergarten pre-registration for all Whitehorse schools opens.

- **Monday, February 20, 12:00 noon**
 - Last day to pre-register for French Immersion Kindergarten using online form.
After this date, Early Immersion places are on a first come, first serve basis.

- **Monday, February 27, 12:00 noon**
 - By this date, you will have received an email from the Department to inform you whether your child has been accepted to the school you have registered for (whether there is a lottery or not).

- **Friday, March 10, 3:00 p.m.**
 - Last day to confirm acceptance of your child's assigned school.

KINDERGARTEN PRE-REGISTRATION

1. Between 9:00 a.m. on Monday, February 13, and 12:00 noon on Monday, February 20, fill out the online Kindergarten pre-registration form located at www.education.gov.yk.ca/kindergarten.html.
 - a. Select your program and matching school as provided on the form. If in French Immersion, select your preferred school, either École Whitehorse Elementary School or Selkirk Elementary School.

2. By February 27 at noon, you will have received an email from the Department to inform you whether your child has been accepted to the school you have registered for (whether there is a lottery or not).

3. If you decide to accept the school to which your child has been assigned:
 - a. Confirm your acceptance **before 12:00 noon on Friday, March 10** by replying to the email from french.immersion@gov.yk.ca. (If you are not corresponding with us by email, call Lynn Williams at 667-5127.)
4. If you decide not to accept the assigned school, please advise us so that we can release the spot to another child (frenchimmersion@gov.yk.ca or 667-5127).

Parents who decide not enrol their children in Kindergarten French Immersion for the 2017 – 18 school year, but plan to enrol their children in Grade 1 French Immersion for the 2018 – 19 school year, will not be guaranteed a place in the program; they will have to re-apply in February 2018.
