Developing Norms For Council Meetings

- 1.) Time:** We meet the second Wednesday of each month from 7-8 pm.

- 4.) Decision Making :** As council members the decision making is based on a quorum of 5. We will require good solid information before making a motion to vote. For situations that arise of a conflict nature we will follow the conflict resolution model.
